Saturday, June 13, 2009 - 1:00 pm - 4:00 pm

"Shopping and Sightseeing Santa Fe Style"— Guests will enjoy a leisurely 2-hour open air tram tour through more than 400 years of history, art, and culture. This tour is an extraordinary introduction to Santa Fe, and provides an entertaining, humorous, and accurate portrayal of the "City Different." You will learn about the St. Francis Cathedral, the miraculous staircase at Loretto Chapel, the Capitol, the historic Plaza and the Palace of the Governors. Guests will also get a brief look at Canyon Road. From there guests will be transported just 10 minutes from the downtown area and begin with coffee at the **private** vault of one of Santa Fe's most proclaimed jewelers. You will be given full access to over 10,000 pieces of jewelry---everything from earrings to rings to necklaces to buckles. From traditional southwestern designs to newest contemporary creations---this is a one of a kind shopping experience created just for SPEE.

Monday, June 15, 2009 - 12:30 pm - 5:15 pm

Bandelier National Monument - Guests will travel northwest out of Santa Fe to Bandelier National Monument and descend into a canyon filled with the ruins of the Anasazi Indians, colloquially "the Ancient Ones." Located on the Pajarito Plateau of the Jemez Mountains, Bandelier was the home of the Anasazi from the eleventh to the fourteenth centuries. Excavated over 90 years ago, these ruins were once home to over 200 people, ancestors of today's Pueblo Indians. Guests may walk along easy paths past the remains of ancient Pueblo dwellings, to the cliff dwellings where they can climb ladders to peer inside. If time permits, group members may take a walk further up the path that leads to the Ceremonial Cave, where the Anasazi and later descendants held spiritual rites and celebrations. (This trail is classified as moderate to difficult due to the 140' of vertical climb up ladders.) Then guests will travel on to the Bradbury Museum at Los Alamos National Laboratories, which traces the chronology of the "Atomic Age."

Cost: \$75.00 per person and includes a professional guide, entrance fees, transportation, gourmet box lunch and refreshments and gratuities.
